R.I.P. Our Friend, Daryle Singletary

For those of you who may not know, I used my profit sharing plan in 1997 to partner with my parents to buy a nightclub they had played music in my entire life. They had a local/regional band called Cross Country, who are the very reason I am in this business today. In 1997, we purchased Jewels Dance Hall in Austinburg, Ohio and the first call I made was to Daryle. He was my favorite country singer (other than Haggard), and I wanted him to be the first national act to play our club since it was a polka room that Frankie Yankovic had headlined at decades before. Daryle Singletary came to Austinburg and despite some challenges (due to my inexperience), slayed the crowds in two shows.

We were off to a great start. We owned and operated Jewels Dance Hall for a decade. We hosted many national acts during that time and had Daryle back several times throughout those ten years. He never failed to deliver. One particular show comes to mind. Daryle and I spent the day together in Baton Rouge, LA. doing the Dream Day concert for St. Jude's at LSU for WYNK-FM. There were many acts on the bill that day including Kenny Rogers, Mindy McCready, Bryan White, Rhett Akins and Billy Ray Cyrus. The best part was WYNK-FM sent limos to pick us all up at the hotel that day to take us to the basketball arena. Once there, the limos left. We were all there for the entire day together. We turned the men's basketball locker room into a guitar pull that lasted the entire day. A circle of music that never stopped.


When it was time for an artist to go do their portion of the show onstage, they simply left the circle and then promptly returned after their onstage performance for the 15 thousand who had packed the arena. Daryle Singletary sang all day much to the delight of all the other artists and all of us lucky enough to be there backstage that day. The problem was, I had Daryle booked to play our club, Jewels Dance Hall, the next night in Ohio. He and I had early flights out the next morning to fly to Cleveland, so we did the smart thing and went out in Baton Rouge after the all day show. We had a blast. And I mean a BLAST. Until the next day on the flight to Cleveland (which connected a time or two) and we discovered Daryle couldn't even talk, much less sing.

His band and bus were already at the club and sound-checked when we hit town. Worn completely out. I sheepishly told my Mother (who incidentally bounced that club by herself...Ala Tootsie Bess) what had happened and she looked at me and Daryle and said, "Well, you a**h*les", then she started her regimen of Blackberry Brandy and nursed Daryle until showtime. Daryle took the stage that night and never sounded better. He sang for over two hours for a packed Jewels Dance Hall and slayed 'em, once again, in true Daryle style. To this day, I don't know how he did it.

In 2007, we sold Jewels Dance Hall and had one big weekend to celebrate before we turned the club over to the new owners. Once again, I called Daryle. I told him, "Well Daryle, you sang us into this place and you need to sing us out." He agreed. One last time, he graced the stage and slayed our crowd. His crowd. He has earned a place in country music by never bending and staying true to the music and his fans. He deserves our gratitude, our respect and his long overdue induction into The Grand Ole Opry. I count myself among the many who are heartbroken at this time and send my love and condolences to Daryle's family...and his family in music.
